Maintenance

Water Safety

Supervision required! A child can drown in 2 inches of water.

- Have adult supervision within an arm's reach when children are around standing water, including buckets, bathtubs, toilets, pools and spas.
- Have an adult supervise children when bathing. Drain tub immediately.
- Baby bath seats are not a safety device. Supervision is required.
- When bathing children, turn the cold water on first and then add warm water. Turn warm water off first, then cold.
- Water heater manufacturers recommend a hot water temperature of 120 degrees. If you need assistance, please contact maintenance.
- Do not store electrical appliances such as blow dryers and radios near sinks and tubs. Keep these out of children's reach at all times.
- Keep bathroom doors closed and use door knob covers to prevent young children from accessing bathrooms. Use toilet seat locks and keep lids shut.
- Empty buckets immediately after use. Store upside down, out of children's reach.
