GRILLING SAFETY TIPS

Nothing says winter is over more than that first grilled meal of the season! Here are a few tips to keep you, your family and your home safe:

- Place grill outdoors, away from structures, fences, overhangs and tree limbs
- Do not leave grill unattended. Ensure grill and trays are free of grease
- Charcoal Champs-consider using a chimney starter. Never add charcoal fluid or any other flammable liquid to the fire. Ensure coals are completely cool before storing in a lidded, metal container
- Prefer Gas? Check hose for gas leaks after storing for the winter. Use a solution of dishwashing liquid and water and check for signs of bubbling. If you see signs of a leak, turn off the gas. If leak persists, clear the area and call the fire department. Ensure the grill lid is open before lighting.
- Keep kids and pets away from the grill. Enjoy the fruits of your labor!
