Maintenance

Winter Safety Tips

Prevent Carbon Monoxide Poisoning:

Replace the battery in CO detectors if they weren't replaced in the fall
If detector sounds, LEAVE THE HOUSE, then call maintenance. If anyone is feeling ill or disoriented, LEAVE THE HOUSE, call the fire department and then maintenance
Never run a car or truck inside an attached garage, even with the door open
Do not attempt to heat your home with the stove or oven
We do not recommend the use of space heaters. If your house isn't adequately warm, please initiate a maintenance request

Driving in Winter Weather? Ensure you have:

Properly inflated spare tire, wheel wrench and jack
Shovel
Bag of salt or kitty litter
Survival kit - flashlight and batteries, reflectors, ice scraper, blanket, non-perishable food, wooden matches in a waterproof container, cell phone and bring drinking water on each trip so it's not frozen when needed
