Summer Reminders

PCSing? Please remember that our office requires a minimum 30 day notice for vacating. Your official notice begins when you come into our office for your appointment to fill out our Notice to Vacate form. You do not need your orders in hand to sign. Please call to make an appointment.

Landscaping- Keep yards clear of debris clutter, and pet waste for your scheduled mowing day.

Kiddie Pools- May never be left unattended and must be emptied when not in use.

Trampolines- Require prior approval following these guidelines: padded netting and lock are required, limited to 16 feet in width, and only allowed within your area of responsibility behind home. Please contact our office for additional details and guidelines.

Maintenance Summer Safety Tips

Fireworks are prohibited in housing areas. BE SAFE! Leave fireworks to professionals - attend a public display.

Did you know sparklers burn at more than 1000 degrees? They get hot enough to melt glass! Consider providing kids with glow sticks or flashlights instead.

Keep a bucket of water or a garden hose handy in case of fire or other mishap when using grills, smokers, fire pits, torches or outdoor candles.

Make sunscreen a part of your everyday routine – kids, too! Keep everyone well hydrated and ensure pets have access to fresh water at all times

Drain standing water from plant saucers, kids' toys and other areas. Use unscented soaps and lotions and avoid wearing bright colors and floral prints to minimize insect bites.
