Maintenance Tips

Tips to help keep your AC working at optimal conditions this summer:

1. Make sure thermostat is set to cool.
2. Set fan to auto.
3. AC is affected by the outside temperature. Putting the AC temp too low, especially at night when it cools, can freeze your evaporator (recommended temperature is 68 degrees). Remember, the hotter it is outside, the harder your HVAC system is working to keep up.
4. When you see ice on the lines that go up to your condenser, you can turn off the breaker to the HVAC system to kick start the trouble shooting and thawing process and call us at 781-745-1800. Always give our maintenance line a call for any HVAC concerns at 781-745-1800. Please do not place them through the resident app or the leasing line, as these are not monitored on weekends or after business hours.
