Snow season is upon us. The safety of our residents is our priority. We promise to keep everyone updated on our snow plowing schedule via social media. Also, if you log into the resident portal you can set preferences to receive text message notifications regarding the snow plow schedule. When notifications are sent out, we ask all vehicles to be moved from the streets to the overflow parking areas. You may also notice some orange guides placed on the walkways throughout the neighborhoods. We ask that the guides be left in the areas they have been distributed. These guides are used for the snow plows on heavy snow days. It ensures the plows stay on their designated paths. Extreme cold temperatures are also common in New England. We know many residents are not used to the extreme weather changes. Notifications will be sent out for extreme weather days. Please set your faucets to drip on these days. COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENTS

Community projects are a major area of focus for us for 2023. Residents have been asking for us to address the outdoor lighting in various areas around housing. We are happy to announce that we were able to install over 22 new light structures in the first week of January! There is currently a plan to install LED lights in the 17 cul-de-sacs we have on base and to install solar light fixtures in other areas that need illumination most. We are always listening to the feedback of our residents and are constantly reevaluating areas needing improvement. The next project on our horizon is regarding the trees around housing. We have partnered with a trained arborist to evaluate many of the trees on the base. In an effort to keep housing safe, we are removing trees that pose potential safety concerns. This is just one of the many projects we have planned for 2023, and we can't wait to keep everyone involved in our future developments.
