Curfew for youths/juveniles under 18 YOA on HAFB is between 2300-0600 hours, Sunday through Thursday, and 2400-0600 hours, Friday and Saturday and the night before a federal holiday.

Youths/Juveniles found within the limits of HAFB to include the FamCamp and outside of their residence during curfew hours are considered to be in violation of this instruction unless:

- Accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- Attending or returning directly home from a school, civic, or base-sponsored function.
- Traveling directly home upon completion of, or traveling directly to their place of employment.

The Continental Congress approved the final wording of the Declaration of Independence on July 4, 1776, after working for a couple of days on the draft submitted on July 2nd and finally agreeing on all of the edits and changes.



July 4, 1776, became the date included on the Declaration of Independence and the beautiful handwritten copy that was signed in August, 1776 - now displayed at the National Archives in Washington D.C.
