Recipe Corner

Skinny Veggie Lasagna:

INGREDIENTS

3 cups chopped veggies of your choice

1/2 chopped onion

2 tbsp. minced garlic

1 Tbsp. olive oil

1 cup low fat ricotta cheese

1 egg

2 cups fresh spinach

2 cups tomato sauce

12 uncooked oven ready lasagna noodles

1 cup mozzarella cheese

INSTRUCTIONS

Sauté the onion and garlic in oil. Add other veggies and sauté until tender. Whisk egg into ricotta cheese and stir in fresh spinach. Pour a little sauce into the bottom of a greased 9x13 pan. Top with 4 lasagna noodles, 1/2 cup ricotta mixture, 1/2 of the veggies, and 3/4 cup sauce. Repeat. Top entire pan with noodles, remaining sauce, and mozzarella cheese. Cover and bake for 40 minutes. Uncover and cook for an additional 10 minutes.

Landscaping Team is Back on Base

You may have seen them cleaning up from the recent wind and rain storms that have come our way this spring. April showers bring May flowers, right? Thankfully our flowers, spring blossoms, and springtime critters are not affected by COVID-19. It's so wonderful to see spring colors and greener grass coming to life. With these changes comes mowing and pruning for our landscapers. Please ensure that your lawn is free of animal waste and other obstacles that present challenges to the care of your lawn.

- Currently, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, items left outside
 the trash bins will not be picked up by the trash company to
 minimize contact with personal belongings. We have added
 3 open-top dumpsters locations for residents to use for
 overflow trash. We have one at the end of Patterson Road,
 two by the warehouse, and one between Liberty 17 and 19.
- This time of year is a good time to have the coils under your refrigerator cleaned. If you look at the bottom of your fridge, there will be a plastic grate which easily pulls off. You'll need a vacuum with a hose once you pull off the grate and take a look underneath. Once you pull off the grate take a look underneath. Pet fur is the number one reason these coils clog up. Simply take the vacuum hose and clean out as much as you can in the front of the fridge. After you are done, reattach the plastic grate that snaps into place.
