Maintenance Update

We have resumed our work on routine work orders and appreciate your patience as we catch up on those that were temporarily held due to COVID-19 safety precautions. If you call in a work order, we will ask you three screening questions and the Maintenance Technician will be asking you additional questions prior to arriving at your home to ensure everyone's safety as we try and respond to resident needs as promptly as possible. We strongly encourage the use of the Hunt Resident Application for all routine work order submissions, as you can submit them at your convenience and track the work order via the application. Always call the maintenance line with emergency work orders please. That number is 781-861-1471 and is staffed 24/7 to ensure our best response to you. A helpful tip - when submitting a work order, please provide as much detail as to the problem, and location as possible. (ie: bedroom on the right, fart hest from staircase) if one of three bedrooms has a light bulb out)

Recipe Corner

Autumn Rolls for the Non Pumpkin Spice Enthusiasts:

INGREDIENTS

- 1 refrigerated pizza dough
- 2 Tbsp brown sugar
- 1 ½ tsp apple pie spice (or cinnamon and nutmeg)
- 2 large apples
- ½ cup raisins
- ¼ cup chopped pecans
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- 2 tsp. brown sugar

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat oven to 400 and line baking sheet with parchment paper. Core and chop apples into small pieces and mix with raisins, pecans, vanilla and 2 tsp. brown sugar, in a small pan. Cook mixture on medium heat and covered for about 5 minutes, or until apples are soft. Mix 2 Tbsp of brown sugar with the apple pie spice in a small bowl. Roll pizza dough out, and sprinkle spice mixture on dough. Spread the apple mixture (careful as it may still be warm) evenly on dough. Roll dough into a log, and cut into 1 inch thick slices. Bake for 12-14 minutes. You can make these without the nuts and adjust sugar as you wish.
